Developments at Robertsbridge

Since the last newsletter, work has continued at the RVR site in Robertsbridge. At the beginning of the year, the PMV wagon was shunted closer to our area at the site which now means it is more-or-less adjacent to the tram bodies which is quite beneficial. Inside the wagon, Roy and Derek have now fitted a wood burning stove (for those cold winter days!) and electrics (to run the kettle!), which means the tram club is now virtually self-sufficient at Robertsbridge. Despite the bad weather at the beginning of the vear, a small amount of work has been done on the tram car bodies recently. Mostly, work has been focused on fitting some new panes of glass in the windows of car 56 to make it more presentable to visitors.

Work which still needs to be completed includes the reconstruction of the disassembled tram truck, repainting of the outside of the PMV wagon and construction of some dummy platforms for the two tram cars.
